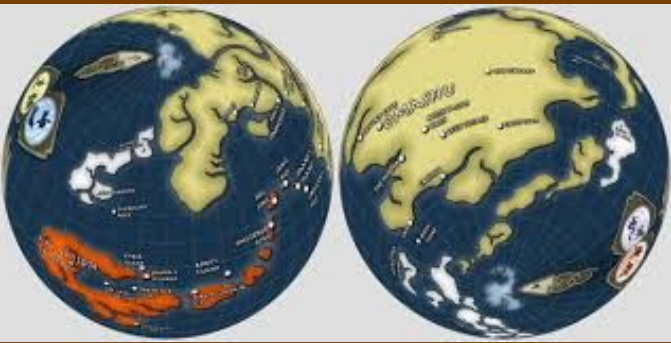
Dream(s): To find his missing parents and save the world from a giant meteor.

Chapter Two: A Surprise



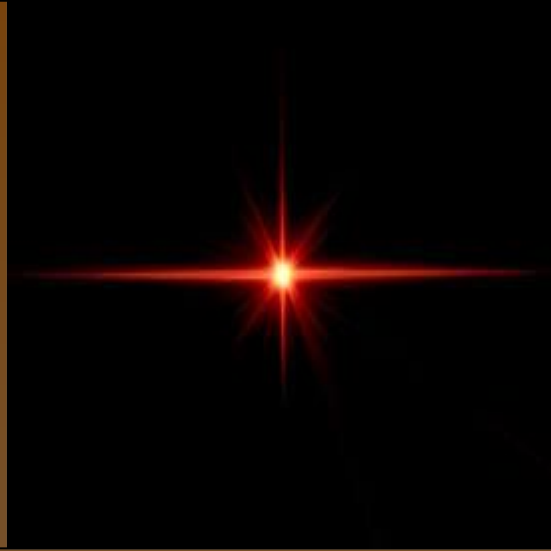
"Hey don't stress about it, plus its your birthday tomorrow," Yun said
