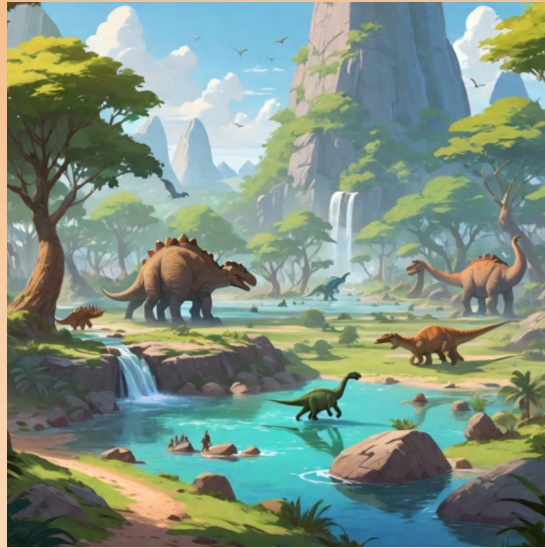
While Rooster was preparing for the worst and trying to solve this situation, humans were finding the easiest way to destroy everything the dinosaurs had. From their homes all the way to their families.
