Whenever Jooley has to save someone's life or needing to evacuate, he goes through his escape door that's a slide. Fun fact, he actually created this room himself.





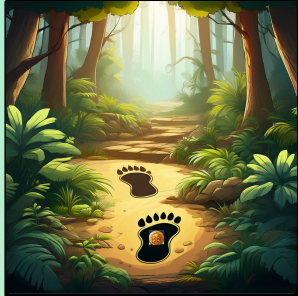
Chapter One: Meet Jooley

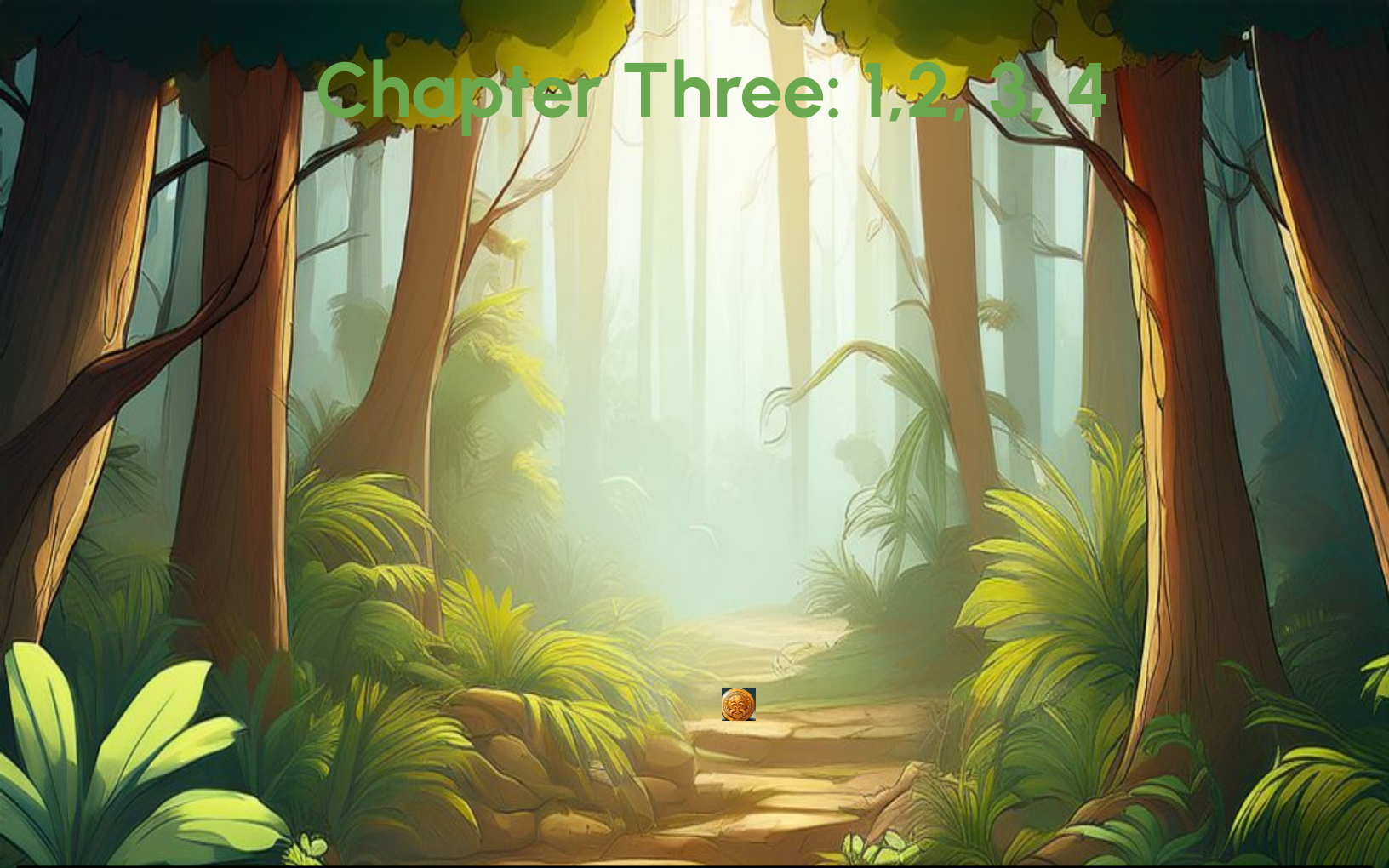
"Why is this here? There's no way my Grandpa came back to life and just left it there." I said.

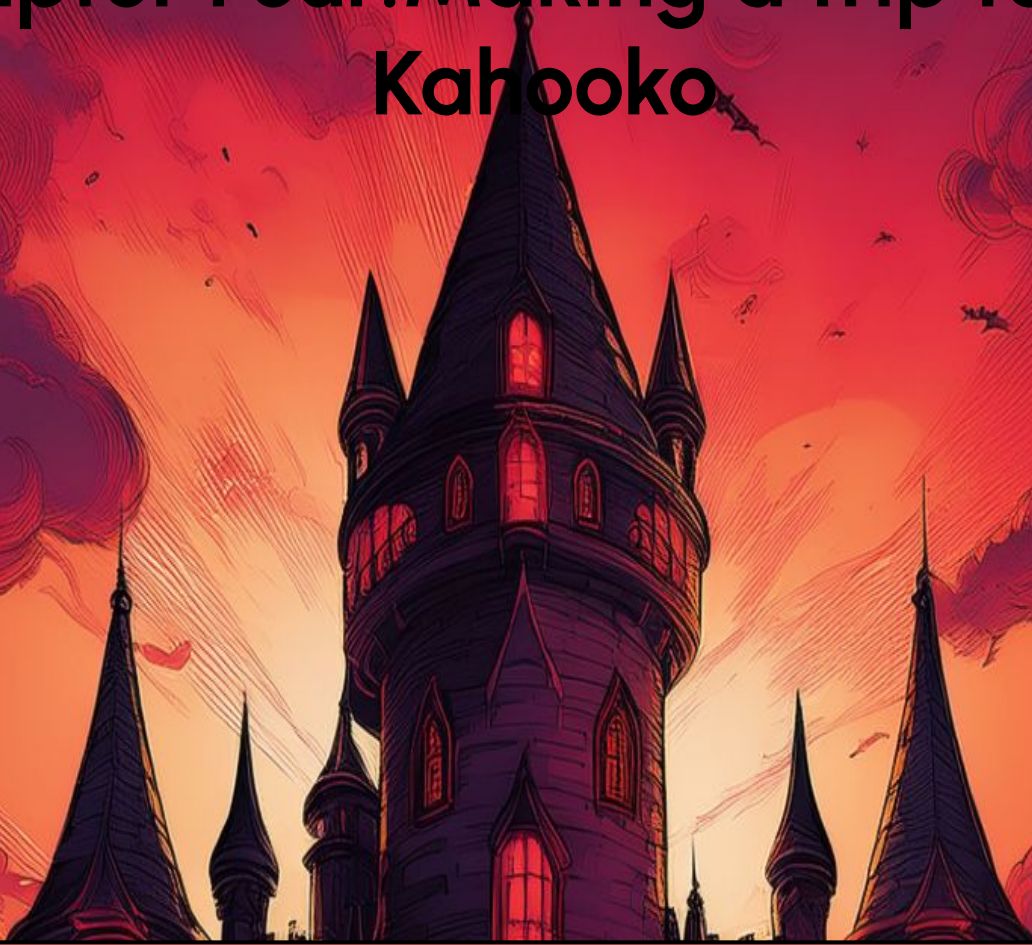
My reaction to Yemiroo telling me this reasoning left me speechless. I never thought Yemi was that smart.

"What...Uh, I-I uh, how did you even have the chance to sneak those in our bag?"

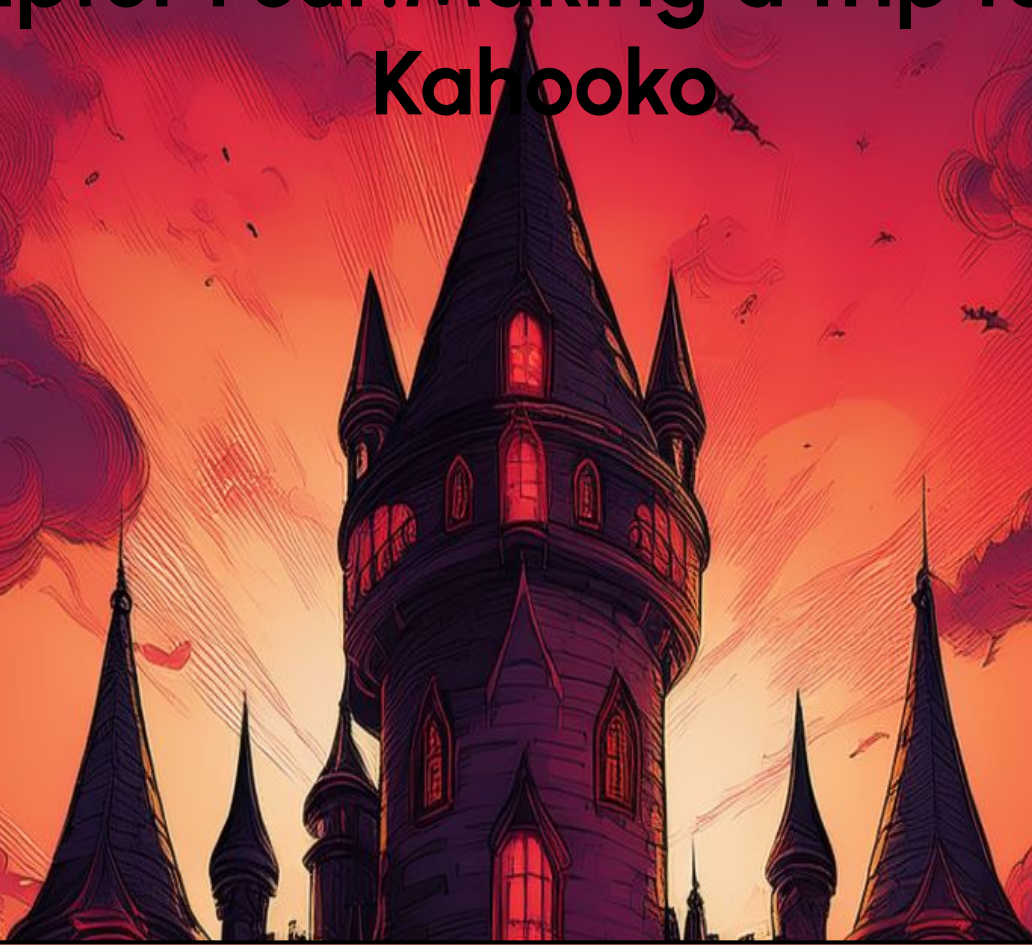
"I have my ways." said Yemi with a confident voice.

"OMG you're right, it was giving us signs to go to him."said Yemi in a proud voice.

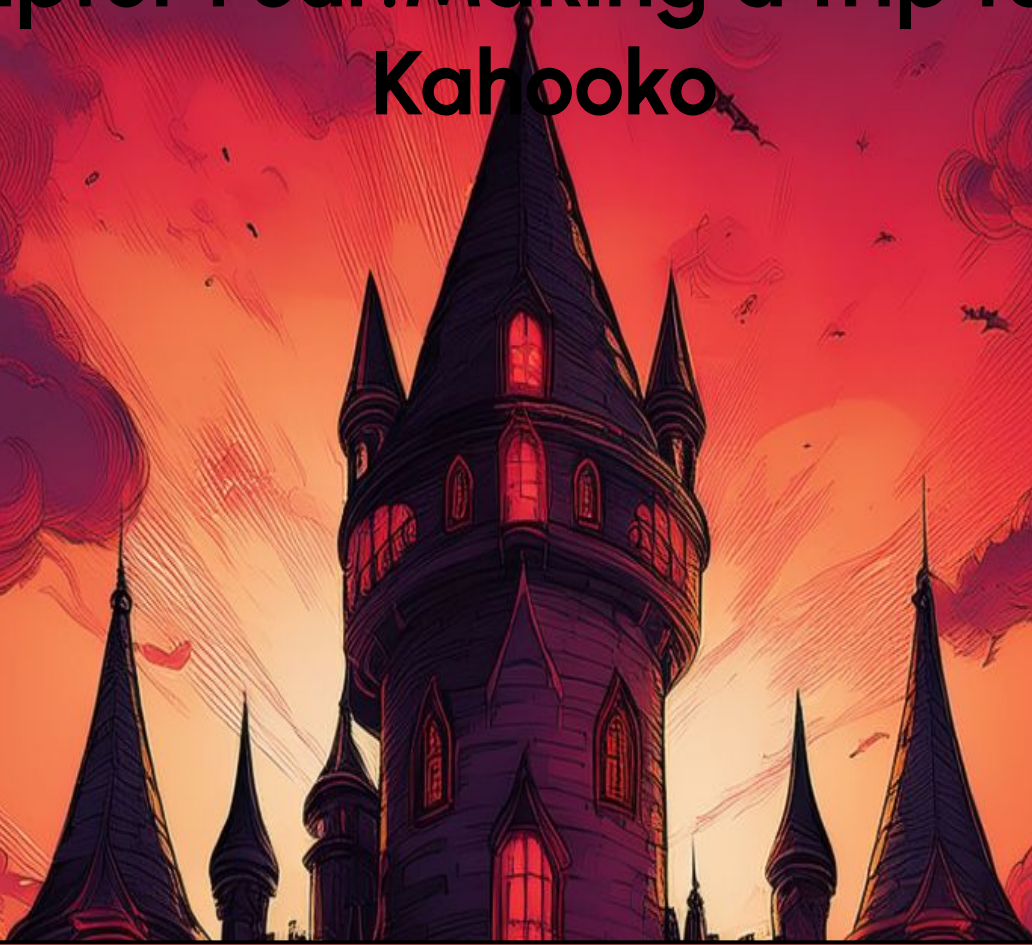
It was offical, we are actually gonna go visit my Grandpa's brother, the leader of Jubabiba, Kahooko.

"Wait, where is it?" I said.

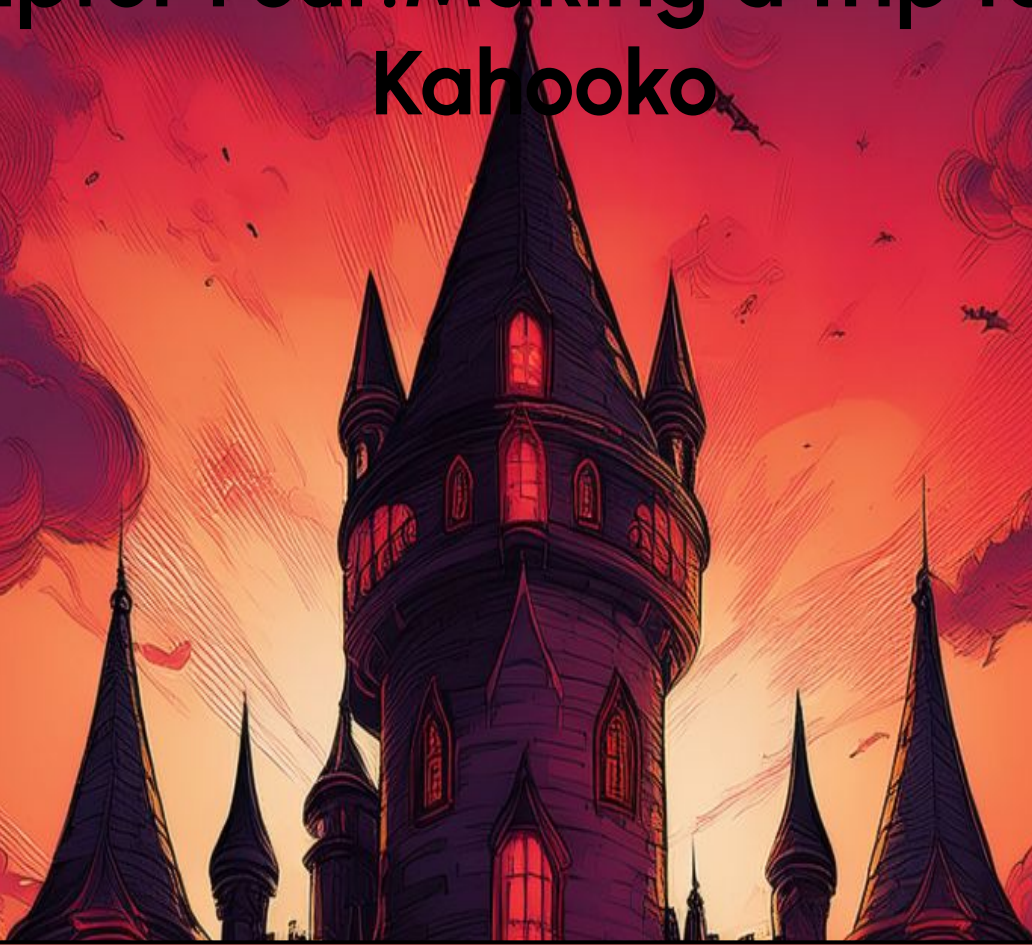
"Where is what?" said Yemi.

"No, no I know Kahooko wouldn't just let someone in," I said.

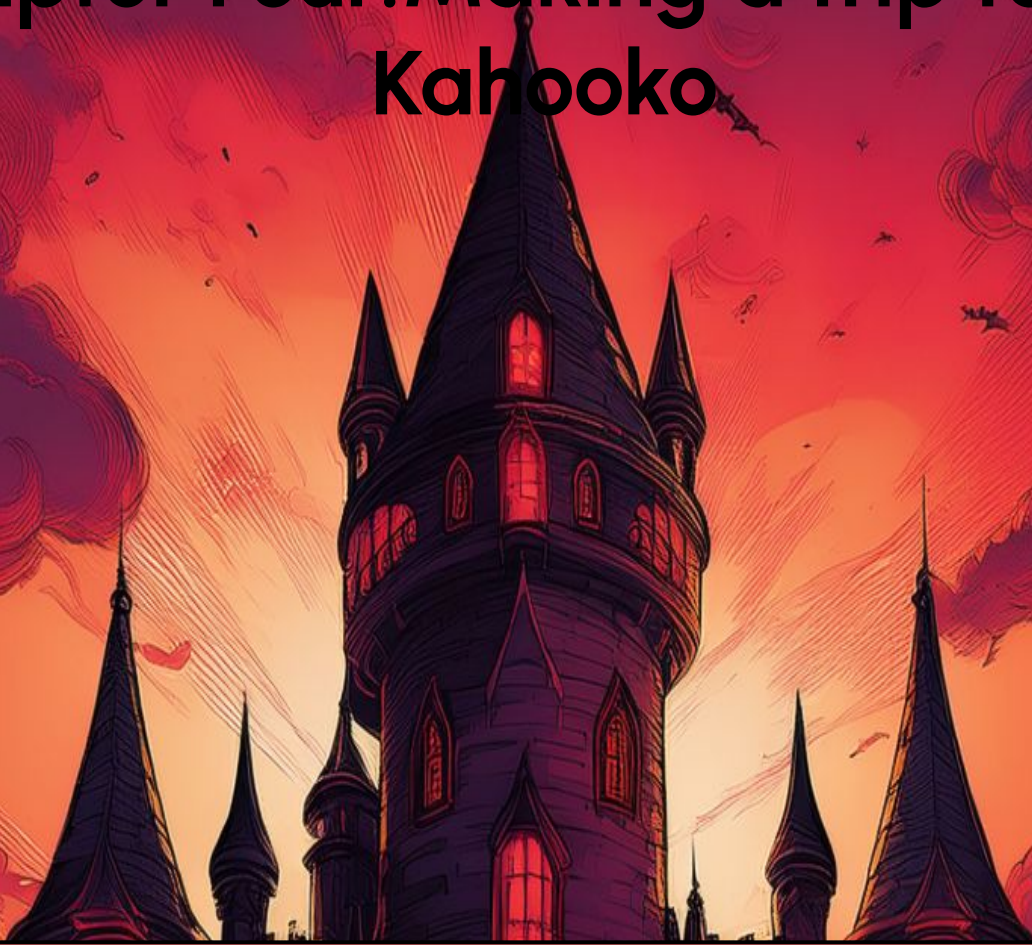
We were going in and saw that the main doors were also opened but this time fully opened. We walked in and saw random guards in front of us.

"Is that," said Yemi.

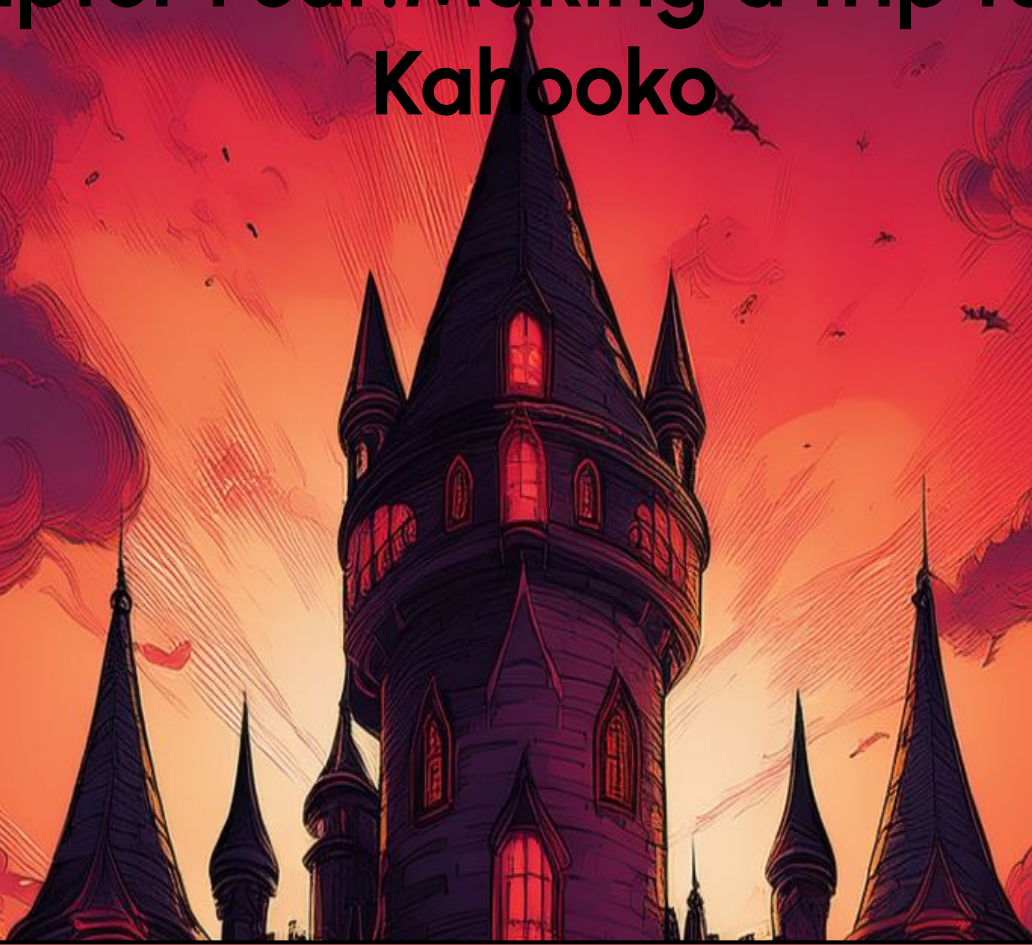
"Yep, my famous old man," I said while my voice was trembling.

"I believe you are my grandpa's brother, uh he was Maideo Joel." I said, *GASP*.

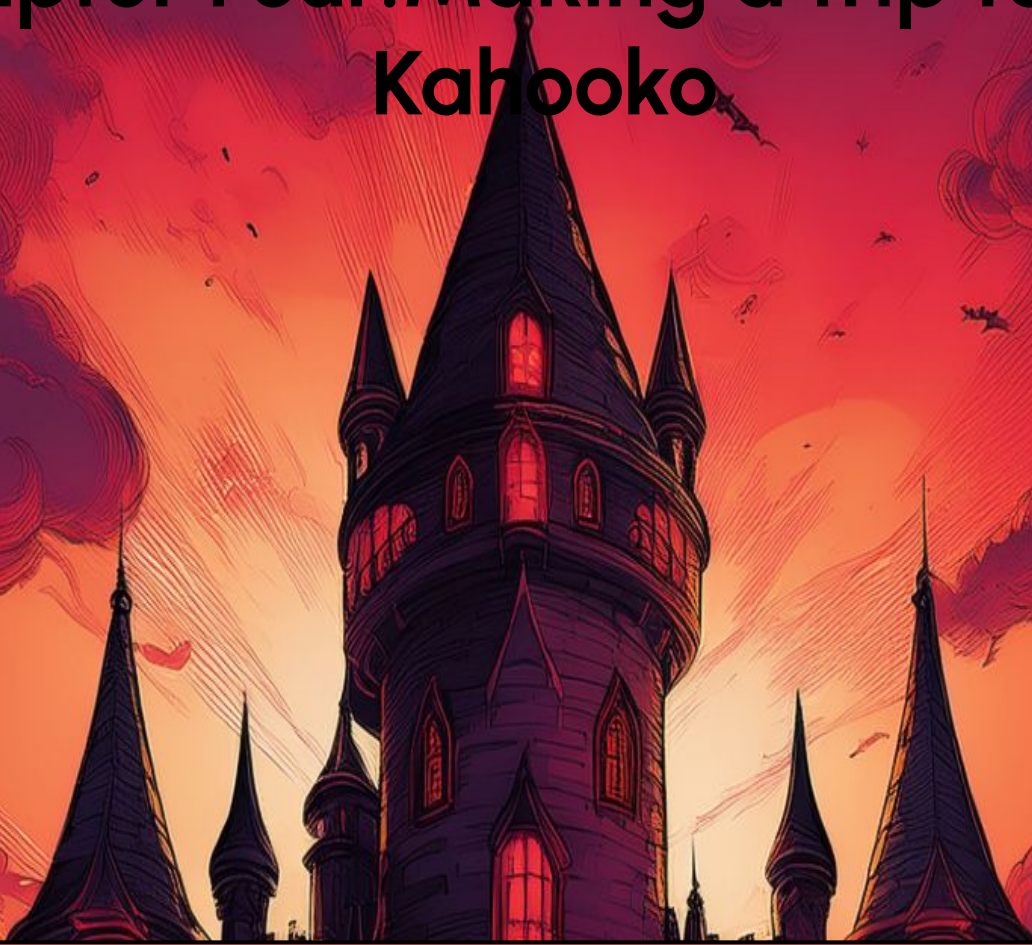
"You, you are that Jooley? Jooley Joel?" said Kahooko with a shocking face.

"But-wait how do you know that?" I said in a frustrated voice.

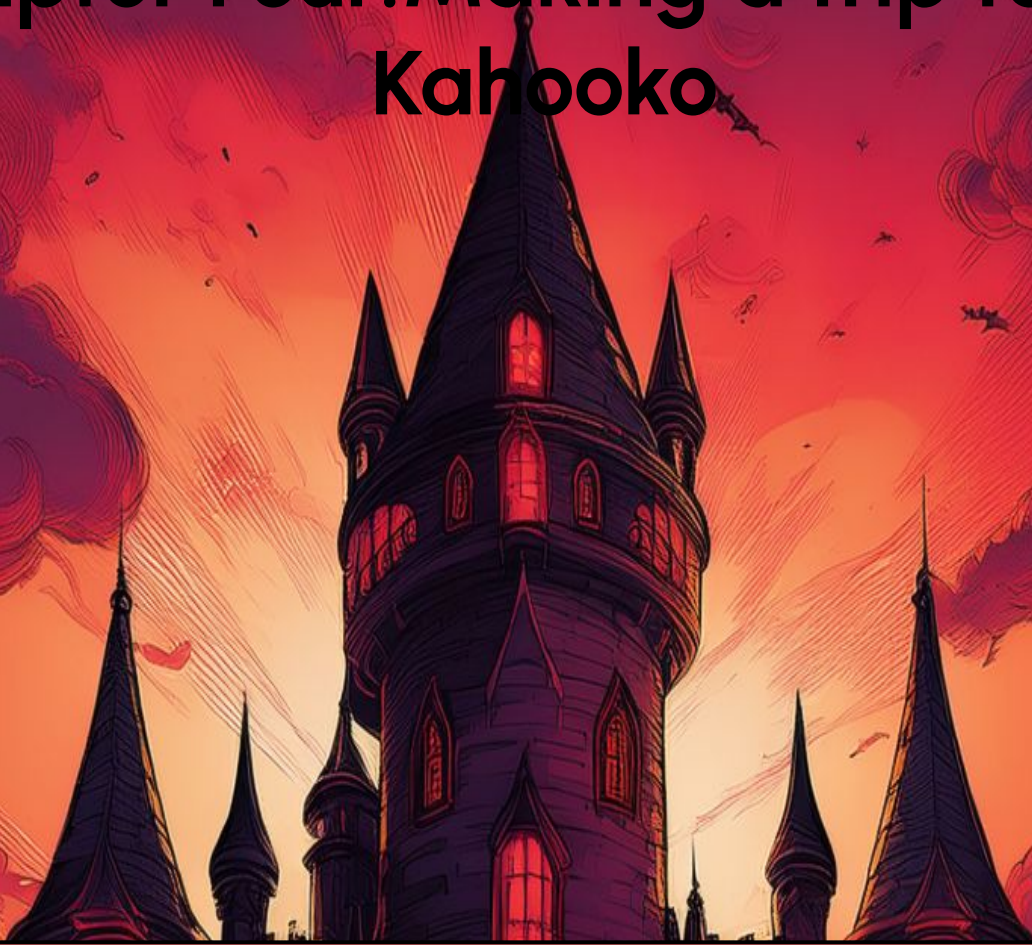
"Uh-I-I," he hesitated.
