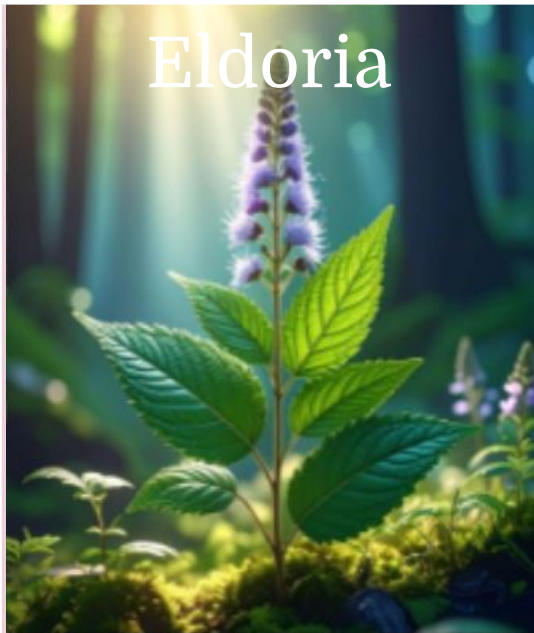

The Flixie Heldoria ring has a constant pink glowing and sparkling center followed by an sweet nectar around the center. Making it look extremely beautiful.

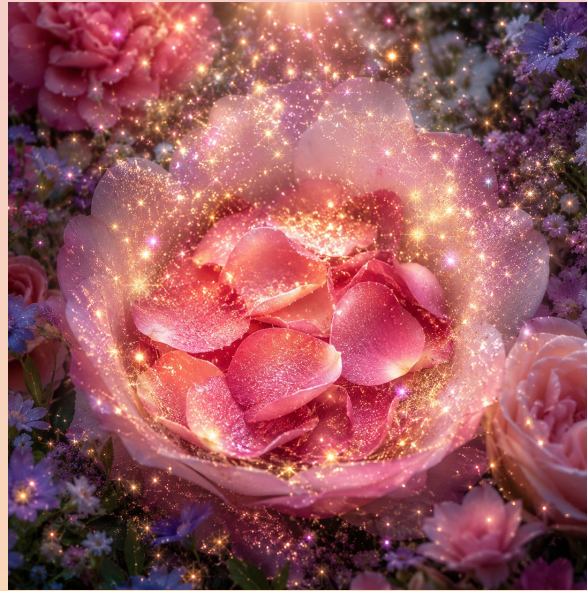
◆ Healing

I slowly stand up, still slightly startled by all the people surrounding me. I head to the first pillar, walking toe to heel at a steady pace.

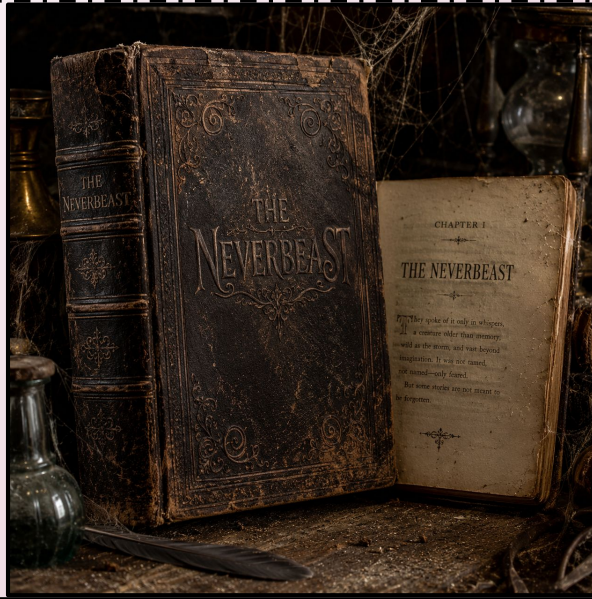
Chapter One: Blossom

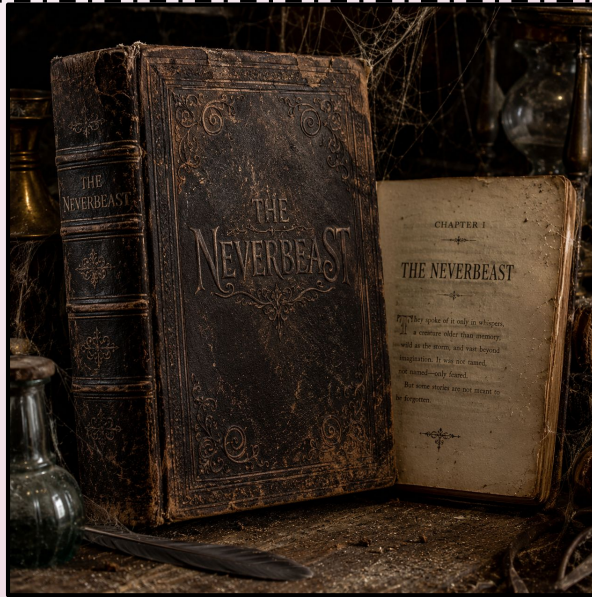
Chapter Two: Neverbeast
